What is Dystonia?

Dystonia is a rare brain disorder that causes extreme muscle spasms so intense they produce involuntary movements and postures of the body and limbs. Gait, balance, speech, and vision may be impaired due to the twisting, painful contortions. Put quite simply, people with dystonia cannot control the movement of their own bodies. The disorder affects people of all ages and backgrounds. Because it is often misdiagnosed, patients can spend years without proper treatment. You can help the DMRF change this.

Dystonia Zoo Days are part of a national campaign that promotes awareness of dystonia, connects the dystonia community, and supports the work of the DMRF.
