What is a Dystonia Zoo Walk?

Dystonia Zoo Walks are family-friendly community events that raise awareness of the brain disorder dystonia and support the work of local support groups and the Dystonia Medical Research Foundation (DMRF). Participants form teams to represent families impacted by dystonia, honor an affected friend or colleague, and to represent local businesses and healthcare institutions. A day at the zoo is a fun and accessible activity for people of all ages and abilities and each Dystonia Zoo Walk combines educational opportunities and awareness activities in a festival atmosphere. Rather than a traditional distance walk, which would not be possible for many people with dystonia, teams spend the day enjoying the zoo at their leisure, raising awareness and helping to inform the public about dystonia.

Special guests, including medical experts, public officials, and members of the dystonia community, are also invited to share their stories and talk about the need for improving diagnosis rates and investing in research. The Philadelphia Zoo Walk has been covered by TV, radio and newspaper in response to the compelling human interest stories embodied by local patients. Dystonia Zoo Walks attract thousands of participants and generate over 150,000 impressions on these high-traffic weekend days.

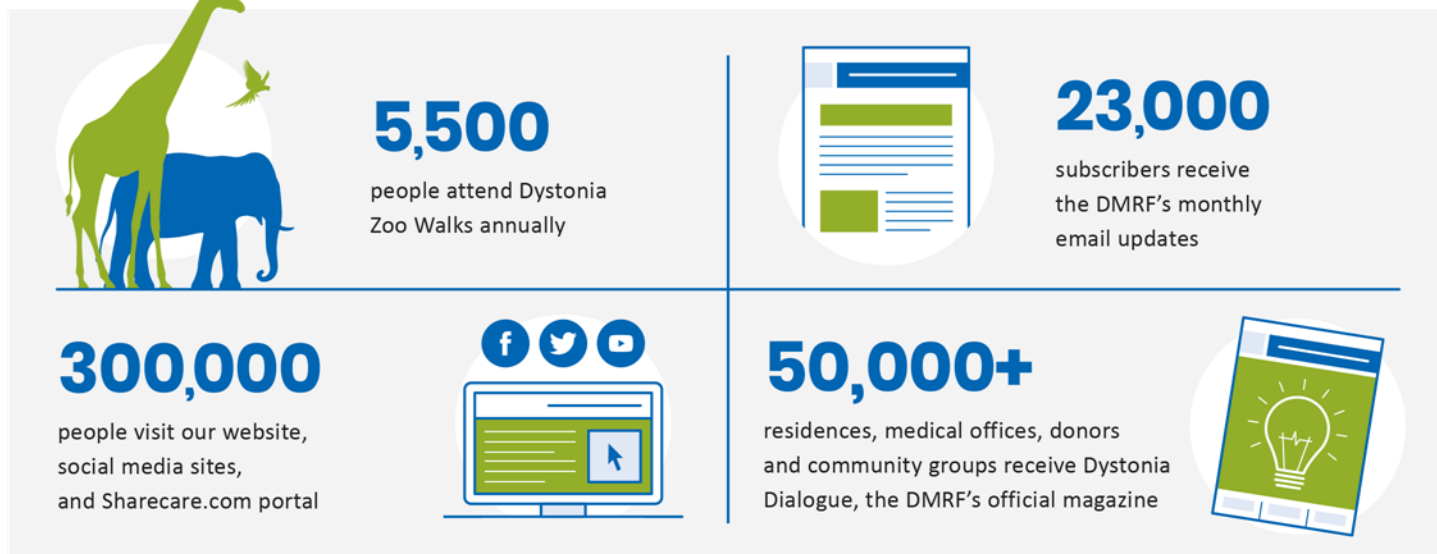
More than 500 people are expected to attend the 4th annual Philadelphia Dystonia Zoo Walk.

What is Dystonia?

Dystonia is a brain disorder that causes extreme muscle spasms so intense they produce involuntary movements and postures of the body and limbs. Gait, balance, speech, and vision may be impaired due to the twisting, painful contortions. Put quite simply, people with dystonia cannot control the movement of their own bodies and many live in constant pain.

Dystonia is the third most common movement disorder following essential tremor and Parkinson's disease. The disorder affects people of all ages, including many children. Dystonia is often misdiagnosed and patients may spend years without proper treatment.
